Stonewall Bridge Closed For Two Days For Construction Preparation

Carlisle, PA – Stonewall Bridge in Southampton Township will be closed for geotechnical borings on Monday, Aug. 10 from 7 a.m. until 5 p.m. and Tuesday, Aug. 11, 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. in preparation for its future replacement. It carries about 750 vehicles per day over the Middle Spring Creek.

“The small-diameter borings provide the opportunity to physically remove soil or rock samples for testing,” said Director of Planning Kirk Stoner. “The geotechnical borings provide us data on the subsurface conditions to assist in designing the bridge.”

This bridge is part of a 3-bridge bundle that the county is preparing for replacement including , Roush Bridge that carries Dickinson School Road over the Yellow Breeches in Dickinson Township, and Burgner Bridge that carries Burgner Road over the Condoquinet Creek in Lower Frankford Township.

The entire construction cost Stonewall is \$1.7 million, with a total for all three bridges at \$4.3 million. Construction is scheduled to begin on all three bridges in the spring of 2021.
