

FOR ABSENTEE & MAIL-IN BALLOT STATUS UPDATES

*****Please note: This tracking site is for Mail-In & Absentee voting only and is only active immediately preceding & immediately following each election.**

Has my application been processed?

If your application has been processed by our office the status will be listed as “PEND – NOT YET RETURNED” (see example below). These fields will update as your ballot progresses through the mail ballot process. Ballots will be sent approximately 3 weeks prior to both the primary/election.

Your ballot has not yet been returned to CUMBERLAND county. The status of your ballot will be updated once the county receives your ballot.						

The “Ballot Mailed On” field will update when your ballot has been mailed.

The “Ballot Received” field will update when your ballot has been received in our office.

The “Status” field will update as your ballot progresses through the mail ballot process.

A description of this status is also provided.

If your application has yet to be processed or if there isn’t an application on file, you will see the following. You can continue to check the website, or you may contact our office to inquire about your application. Applications are processed in the order in which they were received.

We are unable to match your information with our records.

You may edit your information and try your search again or you may contact your county election office to confirm the status of your ballot.

Has my ballot been received?

If your ballot was issued, voted and returned to our office after following all directions provided, your status will be listed as **“RECORD – BALLOT RECEIVED”**. This means that your ballot was returned to our office, and your ballot will be counted on election day.

Has my ballot been counted?

One week following the election, if your ballot was counted, your status will remain as “RECORD – BALLOT RECEIVED” but **the message will be updated** to indicate that your ballot was counted.

ANNUAL/PERMANENT ABSENTEE & MAIL-IN VOTERS

***Please note: Permanent or Annual means that you are signed up to receive an application on a permanent/annual basis.*

If you signed up to be an annual mail-in voter, or if you signed up to be a permanent absentee voter, you will receive an application at the beginning of each year. **This ONE application will serve as a ballot request for both the primary and election of that calendar year.**

TO CANCEL THE ANNUAL/PERMANENT ABSENTEE OR MAIL-IN STATUS
