Additional Hours Provides Voters Extra Time to Hand-Deliver Voted Ballots

Bureau of Elections Office will be open Saturday, Oct. 24, 8 a.m. – Noon, and Thursday, Oct. 29, 4:30 p.m. – 8 p.m.

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Commissioners today voted to provide additional hours for residents to hand deliver their voted mail-in or absentee ballot for the General Election.

Voters can hand deliver their voted ballots to 1601 Ritner Highway, Suite 201, Carlisle:

- **Saturday, Oct. 24** (8 a.m. – Noon)
- **Thursday, Oct. 29** Regular office hours 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. **Additional hours** (4:30 p.m. – 8 p.m.)

No additional voter services will be available during the extended hours.

Last day to [register](#) before the election: **Monday, October 19.** *Postmarks will **not** be accepted.

Last day to *apply* for a [mail-in or absentee ballot](#): **Tuesday, Oct. 27.** *Postmarks will **not** be accepted. Last day to *receive* or postmark voted [mail-in or absentee ballots](#): **Tuesday, Nov. 3 at 8 p.m.** *Postmarked ballots **must be received** by 5 p.m. on Friday, Nov. 6.

The Cumberland County Bureau of Elections maintains voter registrations, conducts elections, prepares official ballots and trains polling staff. The office is committed to providing clear and transparent voter services to Cumberland County residents.
