### **Additional Residents and an Employee Test Positive for COVID-19 at Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center**

**Carlisle, PA** – As of Tuesday, Nov. 10, five additional residents and one employee have tested positive for COVID-19 at Claremont Nursing and Rehabilitation Center (CNRC). The number has grown to 25 residents and five employees who have tested positive since weekly testing resumed on Thursday, Nov. 5.

CNRC management team has been in daily contact with the state's epidemiologist, the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the Regional Response Health Collaboration Program (RRHCP), for guidance and contact tracing.

The residents are quarantining in their rooms in one section of the facility; the staff who tested positive are at home. Everyone in the facility will continue to be tested in accordance with Department of Health and CDC guidelines.

Testing will continue until there are no positive cases. All families have been notified. Since the pandemic began, 17 staffers and 30 residents have tested positive for the virus. All visitation has ceased for the safety of the residents, staff and visitors, with the exception of end of life.
