Cumberland County Conservation District Offers College Scholarships

Deadline to apply: Monday, January 18, 2021 by 4 p.m.

Carlisle, PA – More than three thousand dollars in scholarship funds are available for Cumberland County college students who are majoring in Agriculture, Environmental Resource Management, Conservation/Natural Resources, Forestry or any other related field.

For the past 17 years, the Cumberland County Conservation District has been supporting students through its Environmental College Scholarship Program. This year, four \$500, and one \$1000 scholarship will be available.

“Again this year, the Wilbur E. Wolf Jr. Memorial \$1000 Scholarship will be awarded to the top applicant, said Carl Goshorn, Conservation District Director. “Wilbur Wolf was a county conservation advocate who served the Cumberland County Conservation District for 29 years.”

Recipients must be current college students, who graduated from a Cumberland County High School. They must meet the qualifications set forth by the Conservation District Board of Directors, which includes having a major in agriculture, conservation and natural resources, environmental resource management, forestry or other related fields.

Profits from the annual golf tournament and tree seedling sale have enabled the Conservation District to offer scholarships for the current school year.
