### Change In Hours For COVID-19 Tests Due to Pending Inclement Weather

**Carlisle, PA** – Due to the pending inclement weather, there is a change in time for the free COVID-19 testing in Cumberland County at the U.S Army Heritage and Education Center. Free testing for residents for the weekend is as follows:

- Saturday, Jan. 30, 9 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- Sunday, Jan. 31, 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.
- **Monday, Feb. 1 – CANCELED**

**Where:** U.S. Army Heritage and Education Center  
950 Soldiers Drive, Carlisle

**Who:** Ages 3 and older

Testing is available on a first-come, first-served basis, and registration is available on site. No appointments are necessary. Patients should be three and older, and do not need to have COVID-19 symptoms for testing. Residents are encouraged to bring a photo-ID or insurance card. Test results will be available two to seven days after testing. The pop-up testing is a partnership with the county, PA Department of Health, its provider AMI and the U.S. Army Heritage and Education Center. Mid-nasal passage swab PCR tests will be performed. Individuals who are tested should self-quarantine while they await test results. Individuals who test positive will receive a phone call from AMI while individuals who test negative will receive an email with a secured-PDF. Up to 450 patients can be tested per day.
