Cumberland County Libraries Close for Staff Training, Wednesday, Oct. 27

Items will not be due on October 27; normal operating hours will resume at all locations on Thursday, Oct. 28

Mechanicsburg, PA – All public libraries in Cumberland County will be closed on Wednesday, Oct. 27, 2021, so that library staff may attend a continuing education event.

“Our Library staff will be attending annual training so they can stay up to date on essential skills that affect the way we serve our communities,” said Tara Major, public services training coordinator. “While our libraries are closed, online services such as the library catalog, research databases, eBooks, and our automated telephone circulation system will continue to be available.”

Library materials will not be due on Wednesday, Oct. 27; however, if you choose to return items, locations have either outdoor return bins, or depository slots to return items. Normal operating hours at all locations will resume Thursday, Oct. 28.
