Introduction

In October 2021, Cumberland County was notified by the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts (AOPC) of its requirement under 42 Pa.C.S.A. § 1503 to participate in the reestablishment of magisterial districts. This event occurs every ten years and is directly related to the Federal decennial census. Cumberland County has received from the AOPC a set of guidelines, case filing statistics and work load statistics for Criminal, Non-Traffic, Private Complaint, Traffic, Civil, Landlord/Tenant and Miscellaneous filings in the ten Magisterial District Courts in Cumberland County. The guidelines indicate that Cumberland County shall submit recommendations to the AOPC regarding the reestablishment of its District Courts no later than February 28, 2022.

The following report, along with required worksheets provided by the AOPC, will meet the requirements of the AOPC. The conclusion is that there are no recommendations to eliminate an existing district court and that Reestablishment should occur for all Magisterial District Courts. (Summary attached).

Report

Effective July 1, 2022

09-2-02 - All criminal and traffic cases generated by the Pennsylvania state police on Interstate 81 and the PA Turnpike that run through 09-2-02 shall be filed in 09-3-02. Based on workload calculations from 2019, this should bring this district within the 15% threshold.

09-2-01 - All criminal and traffic cases generated by the Pennsylvania state police on Interstate 81 and PA Turnpike that run through 09-2-01 shall be filed in 09-3-02. Based on workload calculations from 2019, this should keep this district within the 15% threshold, while also putting 09-3-02 within the 15% threshold.

09-3-02 - All criminal and traffic cases generated by the Pennsylvania state police on Interstate 81, Route 581, and PA Turnpike that runs through 09-2-02 and 09-2-01 shall be filed in 09-3-02. Based on workload calculations from 2019, this should bring this district within the 15% threshold.

09-1-03 - All criminal and traffic cases generated by the Pennsylvania state police on Interstate 81, Route 581, and PA Turnpike that runs through 09-3-04 shall be filed in 09-1-03. Based on workload calculations from 2019, this should bring this district within the 15% threshold.

09-3-04 - All criminal and traffic cases generated by the Pennsylvania state police on Interstate 81, Route 581, and PA Turnpike that runs through 09-3-04 shall be filed in 09-1-03. Based on workload calculations from 2019, this should bring this district within the 15% threshold.

Guidelines

For the current reestablishment project, the AOPC has pre-determined the standards by which counties are to review its data and make its recommendations. These standards are all outlined in the document provided by the AOPC, *Magisterial District Reestablishment Guidelines*.

Public Comment

Guidelines from the AOPC indicate that the draft of the Magisterial District Reestablishment Report is provided to the public for a period of 30 days and that comments from the public are to be included in the final report.
