Electric Monitoring / House Arrest Alternative Sentence for DUS Cases

You are being considered for the Electronic Monitoring/House Arrest Program. This program provides persons convicted of Driving Under Suspension or Driving Under Suspension/DUI-Related with an opportunity to serve the mandatory minimum incarceration term as required by law under House Arrest and Electronic Monitoring.

REQUIREMENTS:

- You must be up to date on all payments plans with the Court of Common Pleas or the Magisterial District Courts.
- You must be clear of any outstanding warrants.
- You must be the owner or a signer on the lease of your residence, or have the permission of the owner or lease holder to be on electronic monitoring and house arrest.
- You must agree to the costs, terms and conditions of EM/HA.

FEES/COSTS:

Cost of EM is \$5 per day with an initial \$30 hook up fee

30 days = \$150 + \$30 (hook up fee) = \$180

60 days = \$300 + \$30 (hook up fee) = \$330

90 days = \$450 + \$30 (hook up fee) = \$480

At the time of hook up you will need to pay the \$30 hook-up fee and the first month's costs (\$150).

For 60 and 90 day cases, you will enter into an installment agreement to pay \$150 every thirty days from the date of sentence until you are paid in full.

If you receive a sentence longer than 90 days, your payments will continue in installments of \$150 every thirty days from date of sentence until your sentence is complete.

If the bracelet is damaged, cut, or lost, you will be charged for the full cost of the bracelet.
