Cumberland County Planning Commission Needs New Residents to Fill Vacancy

Applications are due to the Planning Department by Thursday, Nov. 10; Term begins Jan. 2023

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Planning Commission is looking for a resident to fill vacancy on the Commission for 2023. Residents interested in serving must live in Cumberland County and will serve a four-year term, beginning in January 2023. Applicants must be able to attend the commission’s monthly meetings at 7:30 a.m. on the third Thursday of each month.

To be considered, residents need to complete an [application](#) and submit a one-page resume. Application materials are due to the Cumberland County Planning Commission Office by Thursday, Nov. 10, 2022.

A commission subcommittee will review applications, conduct interviews, and recommend a slate of potential members to the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners, who will make the final decisions. Experience in planning is helpful, but not required.
