No Real Estate Tax Increase For 9th Consecutive Year: Commissioners Adopt 2023 Budget

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners today adopted the \$338 million county budget for 2023. The General Fund is \$136 million of the total county budget with no tax increase for the ninth consecutive year.

For the ninth consecutive year, there is no increase in the county's General Fund real estate rate. Real estate millage remains at 2.195 mills and library millage remains level at .166 mills.

The county has maintained its AAA bond rating for 15 years due to strong financial management, and a strategic approach to balancing costs and revenues.

Although the county continues to monitor many areas of concern, we believe we will end the calendar year 2022 in excellent financial condition, and we expect to end 2023 in excellent shape as well. We will continue to use a team approach to monitor our financial stability and to manage operations.

The county continues to pursue opportunities to lower its operational costs, where possible, and to modernize its delivery of services. Throughout 2023, the county will continue to monitor costs, pressures and demonstrate fiscal accountability to the taxpayers, while providing efficient and cost-effective services to the public.
