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County Asks Volunteer EMS and Volunteer Firefighters to Check Accuracy of Information Submitted for Tax Credit

Volunteer Firefighters and Volunteer EMS Must Complete Forms by Dec. 30 to Receive a Real Estate Tax Credit Up to \$250

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County asks all active volunteer firefighters and volunteer EMS personnel who applied for the real estate tax credit to check their mail for a letter requesting clarification sent to some volunteers who had missing or incorrect information. Volunteers have until Friday, Dec. 30, 2022, to submit additional or corrected information.

“We are encouraging volunteers to call or email the Cumberland County Commissioners’ Office to check if additional information is needed to receive their tax credit,” said Stacy M. Snyder, Cumberland County Chief Operating Officer/Chief Clerk.

Some corrections may be able to be handled by phone or email. All other corrections should be submitted by mail or hand-delivered to the Cumberland County Commissioners Office, 1 Courthouse Square, Carlisle, PA 17013.
