


“Examination of Fuel Quality”

VEEDER ROOT

A petroleum storage tank management system that monitors critical tank information

- ✓ Type of product
- ✓ Volume in tank
- ✓ Leak Detection
- ✓ Temperature
- ✓ Water Infiltration

Quality issues start in the ground.


“Examination of Fuel Quality”

VEEDER ROOT

The interior of the petroleum tank can be monitored through probes, MTG, and a Veeder Root.

Tolerance for Water = 0


VEEDER ROOT

Water and particulate is collected from the deepest part of the tank by a vacuum system.

It is separated in a manifold device, and then held in a containment chamber for removal.

An alarm alert system notifies the user that there is a problem to address.

Quality issues start in the ground.

VEEDER ROOT

✓ Water Infiltration

By checking the printout, the inspector can see if the Veeder Alert system has been bypassed, and if so, order the tank to be removed from service so that engine issues do not occur for the consumer.

Consumer assurance of fuel quality added to Cumberland County inspections.





Regulations require proper maintenance of equipment.








