Additional Hours Provides Voters Extra Time to Hand-Deliver Voted Ballots

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Bureau of Elections today announced additional hours for residents to hand deliver their voted mail-in or absentee ballot for the General Primary.

Voters can hand deliver their voted ballots to 1601 Ritner Highway, Suite 201, Carlisle:

- Thursday, May 11, regular hours 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Additional hours (4:30 – 7 p.m.)
- Saturday, May 13, (9 a.m. – 2 p.m.)

No additional voter services will be available during the extended hours.

Last day to apply for a mail-in or absentee ballot: Tuesday, May 9, 2022 *Postmarks will not be accepted.

Last day to receive voted mail-in or absentee ballot: Tuesday, May 16, 2022. *County Election Office must receive by 8 p.m. Postmarks will not be accepted.

The Cumberland County Bureau of Elections maintains voter registrations, conducts elections, prepares official ballots, and trains polling staff. The office is committed to providing clear and transparent voter services to Cumberland County residents.
