

Official Notice of Election for Military and Overseas Voters County of Cumberland

2023 Municipal Election (November 7, 2023)

This is an official notice of an election to be conducted on 11/7/23 in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. You may register to vote and request an official absentee ballot by using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA), available at www.vote.pa.gov or www.fvap.gov. You may apply for an absentee ballot by submitting your completed FPCA by fax to (717) 240-7759, or by email to bureauofelections@cumberlandcountypa.gov.

You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB). Military electors may also use the FWAB, available at www.fvap.gov, to register to vote and vote simultaneously.

You may use the FWAB to vote for **all** state and local offices, and ballot initiatives. To vote, refer to page 3 of the FWAB.

To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives, write the names of candidates or ballot initiatives in the Addendum section of the FWAB. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum). Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a Retention or Referendum question write "yes" or "no."

JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Cumberland County

JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT -- Vote for not more than Two-- All Precincts within Cumberland County

JUDGE OF THE COMMONWEALTH COURT -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Cumberland County

COUNTY COMMISSIONER -- Vote for not more than Two -- All Precincts within Cumberland County

DISTRICT ATTORNEY -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Cumberland County

TREASURER -- Vote for One -- All Precincts within Cumberland County

MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT JUDGE -- DISTRICT 09-1-02 -- Vote for One – Camp Hill, Lemoyne & Wormleysburg Boroughs

MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT JUDGE -- DISTRICT 09-1-03 -- Vote for One – East Pennsboro Township

MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT JUDGE -- DISTRICT 09-2-01 -- Vote for One – Lower Frankford, Middlesex & North Middleton Townships

 - Hampden Township: 1 for 4 years
 - Middlesex & Monroe Townships: 2 for 4 years
 - Silver Spring Township: 2 for 4 years
- East Pennsboro Area School District: East Pennsboro Township; Elect at Large, 5 for 4 years and 1 for 2 years
- Mechanicsburg Area School District: Elect by Region
 - Region 1: Upper Allen 1, 2, 3, 9 & 10; 1 for 4 years
 - Region 2: Lower Allen 1 Annex, Upper Allen 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, Shiremanstown; 2 for 4 years
 - Region 3: Mechanicsburg Borough; 2 for 4 years
- Shippensburg Area School District: Elect by District
 - District A: Hopewell, Newburg, Shippensburg Township, Southampton Township; 2 for 4 years
 - District C: Shippensburg Borough; 1 for 4 years and 1 for 2 years
- South Middleton School District: South Middleton Township; Elect at Large, 5 for 4 years
- West Shore School District: Elect by Region
 - Region 1: Lemoyne, Lower Allen 4 & 5, New Cumberland, Wormleysburg; 1 for 4 years
 - Region 2: Lower Allen 1, 2, 3 & 6; 2 for 4 years and 1 for 2 years
