Cumberland County Planning Commission Seeks Residents to Fill Vacancies

Applications are due to the Planning Commission Office by Oct. 27; Terms begins Jan. 2024

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Planning Commission is looking for two residents to fill vacancies on the commission. Residents interested in serving must live in Cumberland County and be willing to serve a four-year term, beginning in January 2024. Applicants must be able to attend the commission’s monthly meetings at 7:30 a.m. on the third Thursday of each month.

To be considered, residents need to complete an [application](#) and submit a one-page resume. Application materials are due to the Cumberland County Planning Commission Office by Oct. 27, 2023.
