Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County Aging and Community Services will host a listening session on the PA Department of Aging’s development of the Master Plan for Older Adults on Monday, Sept. 25 at 2 p.m. at the Carlisle United Methodist Church.

This is a 10-year, state-led and stakeholder-driven strategic plan designed to help transform the infrastructure and coordination of services for older Pennsylvanians. The master plan will also reflect the needs and preferences of this population to live where they choose and access the support they need to thrive and age in place.

Stakeholders, older adults, and people with disabilities, their families, caregivers, and community leaders are invited to hear an overview of the plan, its core principles, and why such a plan is needed for Pennsylvania.
