Additional Hours Provide Voters Extra Time to Hand-Deliver Voted Ballots

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County residents who want to hand-deliver their voted mail-in or absentee ballots are being provided additional hours prior to the Tuesday, Nov. 7 Municipal Election.

Voters can hand-deliver their voted ballots during regular hours to the Cumberland County Bureau of Elections, 1601 Ritner Highway, Suite 201, Carlisle, Monday - Friday 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., and on Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 7, from 7 a.m. - 8 p.m.

Additional hours include:

- Thursday, Nov. 2, regular hours 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Additional hours (4:30 - 7 p.m.)
- Saturday, Nov. 4, (9 a.m. - 1 p.m.)

No additional voter services will be available during the extended hours.

Last day to apply for a mail-in or absentee ballot: Tuesday, Oct. 31, 2023 *Postmarks will not be accepted.

Last day to receive voted mail-in or absentee ballot: Tuesday, Nov. 7, 2023. *County Election Office must receive by 8 p.m. Postmarks will not be accepted.

The Cumberland County Bureau of Elections maintains voter registrations, conducts elections, prepares official ballots, and trains polling staff. The office is committed to providing clear and transparent voter services to Cumberland County residents.
