County 9-1-1 Dispatchers Received “Stork” Awards for Delivery of 2 Babies

Both dispatchers join the ranks of the Cumberland County Department of Public Safety “Stork Club”.

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County Board of Commissioners today awarded “Stork” awards to two 9-1-1 Public Safety Telecommunicators for their extraordinary efforts by providing detailed medical instruction to callers that resulted in two births.

Terrin Brammer helped a mother deliver a healthy baby boy on Nov. 29, 2023, and Shannon Sprague assisted in the delivery of a baby boy on Dec. 26, 2023.

Both Brammer and Sprague determined the severity and nature of the medical emergency, selected the proper services to dispatch, and assisted the mother and child until the arrival of an ambulance crew.

With the delivery of the two baby boys, Terrin and Shannon join their 27 fellow Public Safety Dispatchers in the successful delivery of 36 babies since the inception of Emergency Medical Dispatch, 31 years ago.

Terrin has worked for the Department of Public Safety for more than 4 years, and Shannon has served county residents for more than 2 years.
