Cumberland County Walk-Off Inmate Timberly Smith Turns Herself In

Smith Now Faces Additional Charges Due to the Walk-Off

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County Warden Travis Shenk today announced that 27-year-old Timberly Marie Smith turned herself in to the Perry County Probation Department in New Bloomfield. She was returned to the Cumberland County Prison at 3:30 p.m.

“Smith is now facing additional charges, those charges will be determined at a later date,” said Cumberland County Warden Shenk.

Smith did not return from work release on Saturday, March 9, after being given a two-hour pass to apply for a new Pennsylvania State ID at the Carlisle PennDOT Driver License Center.

Smith has been incarcerated since March 1, 2024, on a Perry County Parole Violation.
