Mosquito Spraying Tonight and Tomorrow in Cumberland County for West Nile Virus Control

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County is conducting an Adult Mosquito Control Spray tonight, August 12 and tomorrow, August 13 from dusk to 11 p.m., in accordance with the Department of Environmental Protection's Mosquito-Borne Disease Control program (MDC).

The control spray will occur in portions of Camp Hill Borough on Monday, August 12, and in East Pennsboro Township, Lemoyne, New Cumberland, and Wormleysburg Boroughs on Tuesday, August 13, due to high populations of West Nile Virus (WNV) positive mosquito samples in these areas.

The county's WNV program utilizes an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Plan which controls mosquitoes, while limiting health risks and protecting the environment. The county will continue to collect, monitor, and treat water habitats.
