Cumberland County Planning Commission Seeks Resident to Fill Vacancy

Applications are due to the Planning Commission Office by November 15; Term begins Jan. 2025

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Planning Commission is looking to fill a vacancy on its commission. Residents interested in serving must live in Cumberland County and be willing to serve a four-year term beginning in January 2025. Applicants must be able to attend the commission's monthly meetings at 7:30 a.m. on the third Thursday of each month.

To be considered, residents need to complete an [application](#) and submit a one-page resume. Application materials are due to the Cumberland County Planning Commission Office by Friday, Nov. 15, 2024.
