Remaining Residents Who Were Evacuated Can Return Home

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County Department of Public Safety today reported that the remaining residents who were evacuated can return to their homes if they choose to do so. Those residents have been provided specific instructions on what they need to do to return safely.

“Residents have received detailed travel guidance to access their properties,” said Robert Shively Jr., Director of Public Safety for Cumberland County. “We want to reassure the community that structural firefighting crews and equipment will remain on site near their homes as a precaution to help ensure everyone’s safety.”

Some short-term, temporary road closures may occur as trees are continuing to be felled as part of the response efforts.

A “heartfelt thank you,” has been extended from the emergency services and emergency management personnel to all of the effected residents on their patience and support in assisting their efforts to this response.
