ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

AND NOW, this 8<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2025, pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1930.4(a)(3), the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office, through a designee if the Defendant is located outside of this county, shall make ongoing, reasonable efforts to personally serve the Defendant with the Petition, Temporary Order, and Notice of Hearing and Order during the 48 hours following the filing of the initial petition in a Protection From Abuse or a Protection of Victims of Sexual Violence or Intimidation matter. If personal service cannot be effectuated within 48 hours, the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to effectuate service via phone, email, mail, or commercial carrier. If service is made by phone, a reasonable attempt shall be made to ensure that the Defendant is able to receive a physical or digital copy of the Petition, Temporary Order, and Notice of Hearing and Order.

It is ordered that this Administrative Order shall take effect in thirty (30) days.

It is further ordered that in accordance with PA.R.J.A. No. 103, the Court Administrator shall:
