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Cumberland County Pre-Canvass of Mail-in & Absentee Ballots Begins

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Bureau of Elections today at 7 a.m., began the pre-canvass of mail-in and absentee ballots for the Municipal Primary.

After being sworn in, the trained county staffers began the pre-canvass process, which includes verifying and opening ballots, preparing ballots to be scanned, scanning, and counting ballots. Results of the count are not published until after the polls close at 8 p.m.

The Bureau of Elections sent out 16,715 ballots to Cumberland County voters who requested to vote by mail-in or absentee. As of 7 a.m. today, 11,720 have been returned. Counting will continue throughout the day until all ballots are counted.

Residents have until 8 p.m. today, Tuesday, May 20 to return their voted mail-in or absentee ballots at the Bureau of Elections, 1601 Ritner Highway, Suite 201, Carlisle.
