Cumberland County Welcomes 41 New Citizens from 23 Countries at Naturalization Ceremony

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County today welcomed 41 new citizens during its annual Naturalization Ceremony. The residents, representing 23 countries, took their oath in the county's historic courthouse to become United States citizens.

"These individuals have dedicated years of hard work and countless hours to earn their citizenship," said Dale Sabadish, Cumberland County Prothonotary. "We are incredibly proud of each and every one of you. Congratulations as you celebrate this meaningful milestone—your first day as citizens of the United States of America."

The ceremony included representatives from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. The Honorable Judge Edward Guido made opening remarks, the Honorable Judge Carrie Hyams administered the oath, and the Honorable Judge Michelle Sibert made closing remarks.
