County Now Accepting Applications for 2025 Volunteer EMS and Firefighter Tax Credit

This is the 4th year for the volunteer firefighters and volunteer EMS personnel to apply for a real estate tax credit of up to \$250

Carlisle, PA – Active volunteer firefighters and volunteer EMS personnel who reside in the county can now apply for a real estate tax credit for tax year 2025. Under Cumberland County's Real Estate Tax Credit Ordinance, volunteers may be eligible for a tax credit of up to \$250. This tax credit for volunteers provides financial incentives in the form of credits against Cumberland County Real Estate Tax, excluding the Library Tax.

Volunteers must apply every year to take advantage of the tax credit. Firefighters and EMS volunteers, in good standing for at least six months during the time-period of Jan. 1 through Nov. 30, 2025, are encouraged to apply. Active volunteers who were injured during a response to an emergency call and can no longer serve due to injury are eligible for the tax credit for the succeeding five tax years.

Submission Processes:

Volunteers:

- Must submit a completed and signed [Cumberland County tax credit application](#) and a copy of their official tax receipt.
- Bank statements and canceled checks will *not* be accepted to apply for the tax credit.
- All completed documentation must be received by **Nov. 15, 2025**.

Fire Company or EMS Chief/Manager:

- Must submit a [certification form](#) that is a complete and accurate list of all volunteers who have met the organization's requirements and have been in good standing for at least six months between Jan. 1 and Nov. 30.
- All completed documentation must be received by **Dec. 15, 2025**.
