Cumberland County to Conduct Mosquito Control Spray

Spraying Scheduled for July 28-29 Due to High Populations of West Nile Virus Positive Mosquitoes

Carlisle, PA – Cumberland County will conduct an adult mosquito control spray on Monday, July 28, and Tuesday, July 29, from dusk to 11 p.m. The spraying is part of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection’s Mosquito-Borne Disease Control Program (MDC) and is being conducted due to high populations of West Nile Virus (WNV) positive mosquito samples.

Spraying will take place in parts of the following three Cumberland County municipalities:

- Monroe Township
- Mount Holly Springs Borough
- South Middleton Township

Residents can help reduce mosquito populations by eliminating stagnant water on their property and by treating water sources that cannot be drained with mosquito dunks or bits that contain *Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis* (Bti).
