Do you have a parent or a friend who needs a little care but can live independently?

We may have the answer.

Cumberland County Aging & Community Services, in collaboration with housing partner New Visions and funded through a PHARE grant, is offering one Elder Cottage Housing Opportunity (ECHO).*

The ECHO cottage is a small, separate residence, placed on the grounds of a host family that provides private, independent living for one qualifying older adult. (must be 60 + and financially eligible)

Amenities include:

- ▶ 1 bedroom
- ▶ kitchen
- ▶ stackable washer/dryer
- ▶ living room
- ▶ AC/heat
- ▶ ceiling fans
- ▶ bathroom with shower
- ▶ stove/refrigerator
- ▶ removable wheelchair ramp

Elder Cottage Housing Opportunity (ECHO)

Quick Facts:

Benefits:

- ▶ ECHO cottages provide safety and autonomy for an older adult with easy access to family members.
- ▶ Improves health of the older resident and reduces stress on caregivers.
- ▶ Easier and less costly than making home modifications. More affordable than a senior care facility.
- ▶ Host family and ECHO resident maintain privacy and dignity.

Requirements:

- ▶ Resident must be 60+ with an annual income 80% of the area median income (\$59,050).
- ▶ Resident must pay affordable rent, no more than 30% of income.
- ▶ Host family must live in Cumberland County.
- ▶ Resident must be able to live independently to maintain eligibility.
- ▶ Resident must maintain services consistent with their level of care determined by Cumberland County Aging & Community Services (ACS).

Cottages:

- ▶ Owned and managed by the housing partner New Visions (a nonprofit organization).
- ▶ The landowner/host family maintains the ECHO property, allowing utilities to the cottage to be hooked up to the host family residence.
- ▶ The ECHO cottage will be installed and then removed once it is no longer needed, at no cost to the tenant or host family.

How to Apply:
