ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 16th day of October 2025, it is hereby Ordered and Decreed, that effective December 1, 2025, the Cumberland County Court of Common Pleas adopts local rule 6113(c).

Rule 6113(c) Procedure Following Arrest for Violation of Protection From Abuse Order

Upon arrest for indirect criminal contempt of a Protection from Abuse order, the Court of Common Pleas shall be presumed unavailable, and the defendant shall be taken into custody and transported by the arresting officer to the Cumberland County Prison Booking Center for processing. The arraignment and setting of bail will thereafter be handled by the magisterial district judge in whose district the violation occurred, or another assigned magisterial district judge.

The Cumberland County District Court Administrator is Ordered and Directed to do the following:

- 1) File one (1) copy to the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts via email to adminrules@pacourts.us.
- 2) File one (1) paper copy and one (1) electronic copy in a Microsoft Word format only to bulletin@palrb.us with the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 3) Publish these Rules on the Cumberland County Court website at www.cumberlandcountypa.gov.
- 4) Incorporation of the local rule into the set of local rules on www.cumberlandcountypa.gov within thirty (30) days after the publication of the local rule in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 5) File one (1) copy of the local rule in the appropriate filing office for public inspection and

copying.

- 6) Forward one (1) copy to the Cumberland Law Journal.
