Cumberland County Places Proposed 2026 County Budget on View

The Proposed 2026 County Budget Does Not Include a Real Estate Tax Increase

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners voted 2–1 to place the proposed \$290 million 2026 county budget on view. The proposal does not include an increase to the millage rate. The county millage rate remains at 2.625 mills, and the library millage rate remains at 0.250 mills.

Cumberland County continues to face significant challenges due to rising costs of goods and services, along with a growing demand for public services across departments. In response, the county remains committed to cost containment and operational efficiency while actively pursuing grant opportunities to support critical initiatives.

The proposed 2026 budget will be on view Monday – Friday, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m., beginning today, Wednesday, Nov. 19, at the Cumberland County Commissioners Office, Room 200, One Courthouse Square, Carlisle, or [online](#).

The budget is on public view for a minimum of 20 days before being considered for approval at the Board of Commissioners Finance meeting on Wednesday, Dec. 10, 1:30 p.m.

Residents can also view the budget through [Questica OpenBook](#), a visualization software that allows the county to communicate its budget data visually and provide greater transparency to residents. OpenBook enables residents to view the budget at the fund level and, if they choose, drill down to the line-item level.
