Cumberland County Announces Mt. Holly Springs Resident as New CFO

Landers replaces Dana Best who will be sworn in as the new Cumberland County Controller in January.

Carlisle, PA – The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners today named Paul Landers of Mt. Holly Springs as the new Chief Financial Officer (CFO) for the county. Landers has more than 20 years of expertise in budget management, accounting and fiscal management.

While serving in the United States Marine Corps, he worked as a resource analyst/accounting chief. Landers was also an accountant for the Department of Defense Office of the Inspector General and the Deputy Comptroller for the 4th Marine Corps District. Most recently, he served as the Director of Budget Services for Lancaster County.

As the senior financial executive of Cumberland County, the CFO is responsible for managing the county's financial operations, including budgeting, financial planning and compliance with applicable laws and regulations. Landers will provide strategic financial leadership to ensure fiscal integrity, transparency, and efficiency in the use of public funds.

"I look forward to serving the residents of Cumberland County, said Paul Landers, chief financial officer. "I take every challenge as an opportunity and will continue to strengthen accountability, transparency, and efficiency across our financial operations."

Landers replaces Dana Best, who has served the county for 30 years. Best will continue to serve county residents after winning the Cumberland County Municipal Election. She begins a 4-year-term as Cumberland County Controller in January 2026.

Landers, a native of Georgia, lives in Mt. Holly Springs with his wife and two children.
