

## RESOLUTION 2026-01

### A RESOLUTION AMENDING FEES FOR THE INSPECTION OF COMMERCIAL WEIGHING OR MEASURING DEVICES

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Consolidated Weights and Measures Act (3 Pa.C.S.A. §4101 et seq.) the County of Cumberland has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture for the delegation of powers and duties regarding various inspection responsibilities from the Department to the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Sealer of the Cumberland County Bureau of Weights and Measures has recommended that the County update annual license or permit fees for each commercial weighing or measuring device which has been inspected and approved by the County Bureau, said fee being for the purpose of defraying the expense of such annual inspection, and to implement an interest penalty until license or permits are paid in full after an inspection.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** as follows:

Section 1. The following annual registration inspection fees are hereby imposed starting in 2026 and until further amended, for the issuance of an annual required license required to operate the following devices:

Section 2. Interest on Unpaid Fees

Any person who fails to pay the required annual registration inspection fee within 45 days of the date it is due shall be charged interest on the outstanding fee or fees at a rate of six per centum (6%) per annum until paid in full.

Section 3. Repealer

All resolutions or part of resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


Section . Effective date.
